SV Arminen won back the Austrian men's indoor crown following a three year break as they won their title decider against HDI WAC 4-2. The competition's top scorer and player of the tournament Sebastian Eitenberger had Arminen on the front foot from the start from a stroke in the first minute and Daniel Fröhlich made it 2-0, a lead they held until deep into the second half. Jonas Fischer put them out of sight with five minutes to go a Dominic Uher made extra sure in a flurry of late goals.

On the women's side, HC Wiener Neudorf were the big surprise package, eliminating the reigning champions HDI WAC in the semi-finals and then defeated the winners of the regular season, AHTC, in the final. It was their first title since 2006.

It was 2-2 at the end of regulation time with Laura Kern and Sophia Klaus exchanging first half goals; Katharina Proksch – later named player of the tournament – restored the lead but a deflected Marianna Pultar corner made it 2-2 in the third quarter.

It earned the shoot-out from which Pultar ultimately scored the vital effort.
